DEFERRED PROSECUTION CONTRACT

ON THE _____ day of February 2013 a preliminary investigation as required by Section 53.01 of the Juvenile Justice Code was conducted and a determination made that further proceedings in the case are authorized. In accordance with Section 53.03, the above named respondent agrees to accept advice and supervision as well as follow rules set forth by the Department of Juvenile Services of Grayson County for a period not to exceed 6 months for the allegations of _____ (). Your last date of Deferred Prosecution will be the _____ day of _____ 2013. Respondent agrees to follow the rules and regulations set forth below:

- _____ 1. I will obey all federal, state, local and county laws including traffic regulations.
- _____ 2. I will avoid persons and places of disreputable or harmful character and not associate with any person previously engaged in delinquent conduct or convicted of a crime, or who is currently on probation with the Department of Juvenile Services. Specifically:

- _____ 3. I will submit to urinalysis for the purpose of drug screening upon the request of the Department of Juvenile Services. I will not use or possess illegal drugs or alcohol there will be a \$10.00 fee for each urinalysis administered.
- _____ 4. I will attend school each and every day that school is in session. I will obey all school rules and regulations and the school officials who enforce said rules and regulations.
- _____ 5. You are to be in your residence every night of the week by 8:00pm unless you are with a parent and/or guardian.
- _____ 6. I will remain within Grayson County, Texas at all times unless in the presence of my parents. I will also notify my Probation Officer when leaving the County for any reason and will receive permission before changing my address, phone number or place of employment.
- _____ 7. I will allow the Juvenile Probation Officer to visit me at home, school or elsewhere including after hours visits.

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- ____8. Immediately notify your probation officer of any change in residence and telephone number if you, your parent or other eligible person with whom you reside move.
- ____9. You are to report to your Juvenile Probation Officer at 86 Dyess Rd., Denison, Texas (Grayson County JPD) as directed by your Juvenile Probation Officer,
- ____10. I agree to perform **40** hours of Community Service Restitution (CSR) as directed by the Juvenile Probation Department. Appropriate behavior during CSR Work Days is required to receive credit for hours worked. Additional hours will be added if your conduct or attitude shall warrant such action.
- ____11. I will attend any and all activities sponsored by the Grayson County Department of Juvenile Services as directed by my probation officer regarding my rehabilitation. I will attend individual and/or family counseling as directed by the Grayson County Department of Juvenile Services.
- ____12. I shall pay a probation fee of \$_____ for each month that I am under supervision with the Department of Juvenile Services of Grayson County, for the total amount of \$_____. All payments are to be made directly to the Grayson Co. JPD with a first installment of \$_____ due on or before February 28, 2013.
- ____13. I will reimburse the Count of Grayson, through the Grayson County Department of Juvenile Services the sum of \$_____ to be paid as restitution payable at \$_____ per month with the first payment due on or before February 28, 2013 and a like sum due at the end of each month until paid in full.
- ____14. I understand that agreeing to Deferred Prosecution does not mean I have been adjudicated (found to have engaged in delinquent conducted or conducted indicating a need for supervision).
- ____15. I understand that any information obtained during the Deferred Prosecution period will not be used against me in any future court hearings.
- ____16. I hereby understand that in the event that my case is transferred pursuant to an inter-county-transfer of probation supervision, the terms and conditions set forth in these conditions of probation may be amended, altered or modified by another juvenile court or juvenile probation department. I further understand that the probation conditions contained herein that relate to fees or the length of probation term may not be amended altered or modified.
- ____17. Avoid injurious or vicious habits or activities.

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Parent's Obligations

- ____ 18. Pursuant to Section 25.093 of the Texas Education Code; you are mandated by law to require the child to attend school and/or obtain an education.
- ____ 19. Provide/arrange transportation for the child as needed to comply with the terms of the child's supervision including but not limited to; CSR, reporting, school, etc.
- ____ 20. Notify the Juvenile Probation Officer before there are any changes in your home or employment telephone number and/or address.
- ____ 21. Notify the Juvenile Probation Officer within 48 hours of your child's violations of his/her Deferred Prosecution rules.
- ____ 22. Attend, participate and successfully complete any social, psychological and/or family counseling to assist in the rehabilitation of the child.

The Department of Juvenile Services will, on successful completion of the contract, dismiss all charges and allegations against _____, and the child and parent(s) will be discharged from further obligations imposed by this contract.

I understand that any violation of the above rules can result in a revocation of my Deferred Prosecution Contract. I along with my parent, guardian, or custodian acknowledge that consent to Deferred Prosecution is not obligatory and that we may terminate the Deferred Prosecution at any point and petition the court for a court hearing in the case.
