- 2. Provide/arrange transportation for the child as needed to comply with the terms of the child's probation including: but not limited to, CSR, reporting, school, court, etc.
- 3. Attend, participate and successfully complete any social, psychological and/or family counseling to assist in the rehabilitation of the child and to strengthen the child's family environment. This includes, but not limited to; Parenting Wisely, AA/NA, Chaperone Training, specialized programs, or any programs.
- 4. You are required to attend any future court proceedings with and for your child including; Detention, Modification, Enforcement, Administrative and Status Hearings. You will be given oral and/or written notice of any future court proceedings.
- 5. Notify the Juvenile Probation Officer before there are any changes in your home or employment telephone number and/or address.
- 6. Report any violation of the Child's Probation to the probation officer/Case Manger immediately.

- 7. Be responsible for the payment of;
 - a. Probation fees in the amount of \$180.00 with the first payment of \$15.00 due on or before June 30, 2012 and a like sum due at the end of each month,
